Pursuant to the provisions of Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we would like to inform you that the Company is in receipt of an order dated 18th March, 2025 from the Deputy Commissioner of Revenue, Salt Lake Charge, Kolkata dropping the proceeding initiated against the Company under Section 73 of the GST Act, 2017 involving alleged short payment of taxes, excess claim of ITC for Financial Year 2020-21 post considering the reply submitted by the Company against the show-cause notice issued in this regard.

The Order has led to drop of GST demand of ₹ 13,53,075/- (Rupees Thirteen Lakh Fifty-Three Thousand and Seventy-Five only), interest of ₹ 9,90,224 (Rupees Nine Lakh Ninety Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty-Four only) and penalty of ₹ 1,35,308 (Rupees One Lakh Thirty-Five Thousand Three Hundred and Eight only) respectively.
